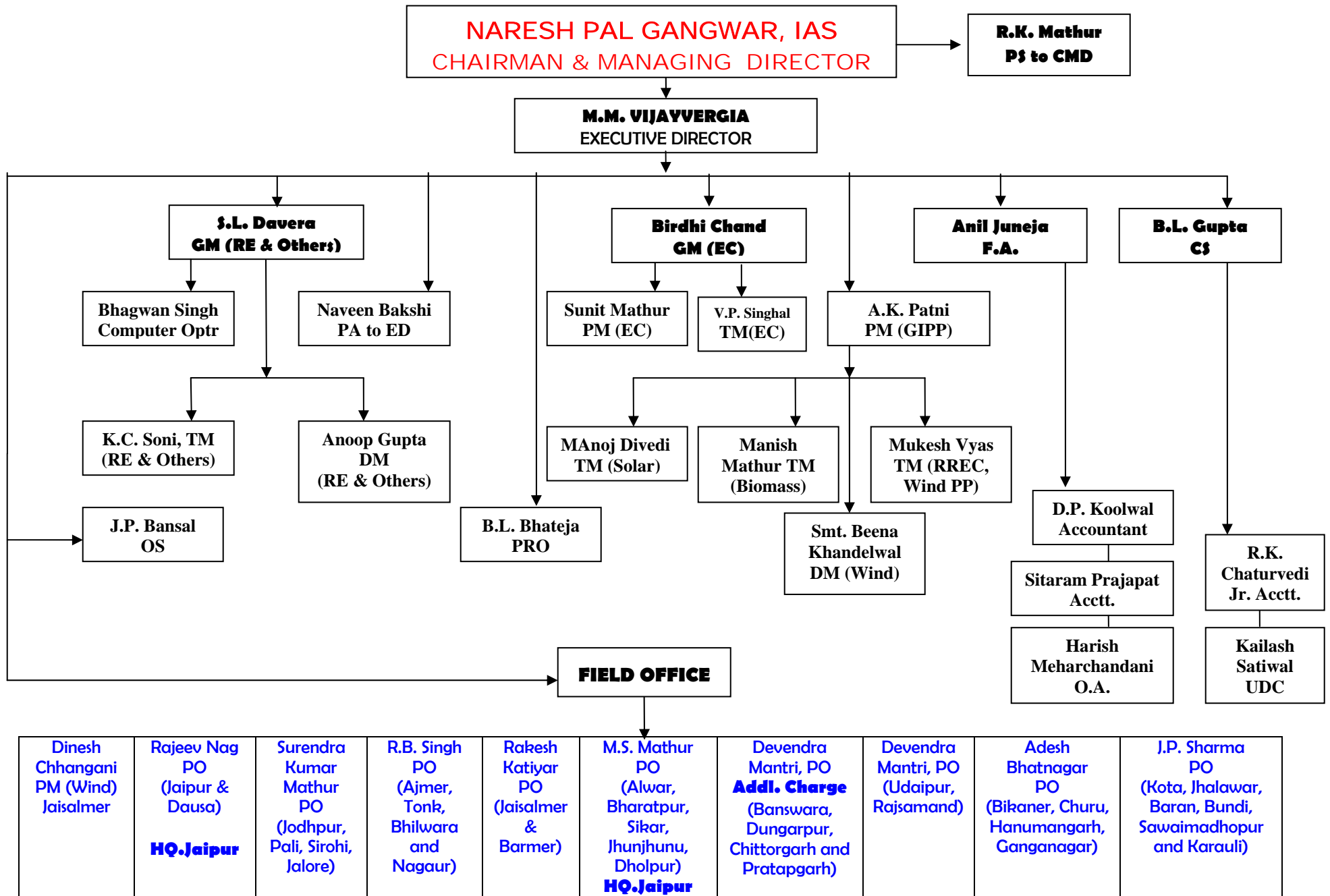

**Mode of Execution of Programmes :**

**(1) Rural Electrification Programme through SPV Domestic Lighting Systems**

RREC decide the prices of SPV Domestic Lighting Systems through open tender system. The selected manufacturers / Authorized suppliers shall identify beneficiaries to supply, install, commission systems and provide maintenance services for 2 years free of charge and for next three years at the fixed CMC charges ( Rs.300/- per year per Domestic Lighting System ) to be charged from beneficiaries. They shall also be required to set up their repair and maintenance centres for providing effective repair/maintenance services to the beneficiaries/users.

The Programme shall be carried out as per guidelines as given hereunder:

- (i) the manufacturer shall be allowed to install the systems conforming to MNES specifications/guidelines after authorisation by RREC.
- (ii) For this RREC shall give specific targets/limits to each selected manufacturers and fix prices for sale of systems to the user.
- (iii) The manufacturers may claim subsidy from RREC by submitting complete list of buyers alongwith full addresses, date of sales, models and makes and serial numbers of systems & PV modules supplied duly verified by RREC's field Project Officer or authorised representative from Head Office.

Scope of work covers identification of beneficiaries as per RREC's conditions, supply/ installation/ testing/commissioning of DLS in the villages situated in the State conforming to technical specification approved by MNES, GOI. Detailed scope of work is given here under:

**Responsibilities of Firm for the Work of installation of DLS involve :**

- (a) Identification and motivation of prospective beneficiaries.
- (b) Collection of balance supply and installation cost of systems from beneficiaries after allowing applicable MNES/GOR subsidy.
- (c) Entering into supply and maintenance contract agreements with beneficiaries.
- (d) Collection of maintenance charges from beneficiaries.
- (e) Completion of work of supply, installation, commissioning and testing as per schedule given at the time of allotting targets.
- (f) Establishing "After sales service centres" in concerned tehsils to cater the maintenance needs of beneficiaries.

**Eligible Beneficiary for SPV Home Lighting Systems::**

Every resident of rural area whether electrified or un-electrified is eligible for getting subsidy on SPV Domestic lighting System.

**Subsidy Pattern :**

Ministry of New & Renewable Energy, GoI has announced the programme for the year 2009-10, the proposals has submitted for allocation of targets of 10,000 nos. SPV DLS under this programme to Rajasthan. Sanction is still awaited for the same. The subsidy provision under this programme through State funds will be as under:

**Programme 2009-10 :**

RREC invited tenders for finalisation of Price of SPV Domestic Lighting Systems and it is under process of finalisation. After finalisation of Prices, work orders will be issued to the successful manufacturer / supplier.

### Solar City Programme

Under MNRE Solar City Programme, Jaipur & Kota announced to make Solar City. Under this scheme Rs. 50 Lacs subsidy to be provided to each Municipal Corporation of these cities. In which Rs. 10 Lacs given for making a Master Plan, Implementation, Solar cell (Solar Department) for each activity and 20 Lacs for promotional activities. Under this scheme instruments of Biomass & Wind Energy can be installed. Cost of instruments to be borne by Municipal Corporation, State Govt., Local Bodies Deptt., Jawahar Lal Nehru Urban Development Programme & Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) respectively. Subsidy to be released by MNRE on priority basis for Solar City.

### Remote Village Electrification Programme (RVE) :

Under the Remote Village Electrification (RVE) Programme of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE), remote un-electrified villages are to be electrified by Solar Photovoltaic Systems.

MNRE is providing 90% of benchmark cost for the Domestic Lighting Systems (DLS, Model-II, 37W) as Central Financial Assistance (CFA). The rest of the cost is being borne by the State Govt. and beneficiaries. Under the RVE Programme 2005-06, RREC has installed 3980 systems in 219 un-electrified remote census villages of Rajasthan. During the year 2006-07. Under RVE Programme 2006-07, RREC has installed 7618 Domestic Lighting Systems in 73 un-electrified census villages of Rajasthan. A proposal has been made for electrification of Un-electrified hemlet of electrified villages under RVE Programme 2009-10. A list of Un-electrified hemlets to be received from DISCOMs. After receiving the list of Un-electrified hemlets a proposals will be sent to MNRE-Gol for sanction.
